Footnotes

KEIAI TOKYO was held up between foes dropping off the second flight racing to the backstretch, angled to the rail when presented an opening on the far turn, continued with a steady advance along the inside racing into upper stretch, shifted outside the pacesetter to challenge that foe nearing the furlong marker, took over and held sway to the end under firm right handed encouragement. MULATA was settled outside foes from well out of striking distance in the opening half, swung out four wide racing into upper stretch and was making steady progress to gain place honors late while closing the gap. MAI TAI MAMA, caught a bit wide racing into the first turn while being prompted to challenge for command, gained the advantage along the inside entering the backstretch, dictated the pace on a clear margin to upper stretch but failed to sustain her momentum through the last furlong. TELMA, forwardly placed along the inside racing to the backstretch, relinquished the lead to a rival after the opening quarter to track that foe along the inside to the second bend,

shifted out three deep nearing upper stretch while being urged to challenge but lacked the needed final kick while finishing well enough to earn a share. HELLO JAKE, forwardly placed between foes in the opening stages, tracked the pacesetter between rivals in the second flight, lodged a brief bid outside the leader leaving the far turn but quickly flattened out. QUEEN OF SCIOTO settled out of striking distance along the inside in the opening half, shifted out to split foes near the inside racing into upper stretch and gained some position in an even effort. UNDER THE RIM tracked the leader inside foes in the second flight racing to the far turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. FRIENDLY SELECTION settled into stride along the inside early and never mounted a serious challenge. STIVERS SUPRISE, reserved off the second flight near the inside in the opening half, couldn't produce the needed closing bid. FORTHELONGHAUL tracked the leaders three deep off the second flight racing to the far turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. PRETTY SLIC CHICK, caught a bit wide early, was urged to a position three deep in the second flight, came under pressure to briefly challenge in that path entering the far turn but quickly emptied out. LATIKA LOVE trailed throughout.
