WILDCAT MISS, urged to secure a narrow advantage along the inside soon after the break, dictated the pace on her own courage into the bend, shook clear nearing upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm right handed encouragement. COUNTRY CAUCUS, carried out by PEACE BRIDGE at the start, was guided to the rail to track just off the leaders, continued with a steady effort inside foes on the bend, shifted out to challenge the winner in upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with that foe but proved clearly best of the others. J S P PALS FOREVER, close up four deep in the opening stages, continued three deep on the turn, couldn't match terms with the top pair racing into the stretch but made an effort to improve her position and gain a share late. SWEET CHI TOWN, carried out by COUNTRY CAUCUS at the start while being forced into the path of SHARE THE JOY, was taken in hand while being reserved out of close quarters, angled to the rail racing through the backstretch, made some progress to gain position inside foes racing into the stretch but lacked the needed final bid. SHARE THE JOY, off slowly then bumped at the start, was steadied along three deep avoiding close quarters racing to the bend, was fanned five wide nearing upper stretch and could make no impression. PEACE BRIDGE broke outwards brushing the gate while drifting into the path of COUNTRY CAUCUS, was reserved between foes from just out of striking distance racing to the turn and steadily faded from contention. RAISINABOVEONLY was a brief factor prompting the pacesetter racing into the turn but was through after a half.
