CONECUH sped to the fore from the break while angling to the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin in hand racing through the turn, drew clear in upper stretch and was kept to steady pressure to maintain his advantage. COAL FIRED tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail from just out of striking distance, made a steady effort inside foes to challenge nearing upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but narrowly prevailed for place honors at the wire. I AM THE SHERIFF tracked the leaders between foes off the second flight racing into the turn, split foes entering upper stretch to challenge, couldn't menace the winner and was just outfinished for second. GRAY settled in last along the rail racing into the bend and made an effort to improve his position inside foes in late stages. STIG'S DEPUTY chased the pacesetter just off the inside racing into the turn and gave way nearing midstretch. LEGENDARY KING tracked the leaders three deep behind the second flight racing into the turn and never mounted a serious challenge. NO GOOD DEED, urged along three deep chasing the pacesetter into the turn, gave way entering upper stretch.
