### Footnotes

DEBUSSY (IRE) tracked the leaders as part of the second flight along the inside to the backstretch while under some reserve, shifted a bit off the inside in search of an opening from which to challenge nearing the far turn, continued in hand when blocked between foes past the quarter mile marker, came through close quarters near the inside entering upper stretch to challenge along the rail, then surged to the lead in the final sixteenth to narrowly edge GIO PONTI under firm encouragement. The latter was settled along the inside for six furlongs, shifted out gathering momentum entering the far turn, circled foes six wide with a quarter mile to go, moved to brief command between calls leaving the furlong marker but couldn't fend off the winner. TAZEEZ reared at the start, shifted outside the field entering the stretch while readily regaining terms with a rival on the pace, moved clear after six furlongs, opened a commanding margin on the second bend but failed to sustain his momentum while shifting off the inside late. RAHYSTRADA tracked the leaders unhurried from well out of striking distance in the opening half, made steady progress between foes to bid five deep near the quarter mile marker but was outkicked racing through the stretch. SUMMIT SURGE (IRE) angled to the rail in the opening stages to gain a tracking position off the second flight, shifted out entering the far turn to bid three wide between foes, raced in close quarters nearing upper stretch and continued evenly between foes in the final furlong. TAJAAWEED, held up out of close quarters just after the start, was settled well off the pace while a bit off the inside to the second bend, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and passed some tiring rivals while making no impression on the leaders. GENERAL QUARTERS was urged to secure a forward placing near the inside in the opening stages, tracked just off the first flight outside a rival to the second bend, made a brief, three wide bid racing through the far turn but came up empty in upper stretch. JUST AS WELL tracked just off the second flight outside a rival to the far turn, switched out to advance four wide between foes racing through the far turn but lacked any further response. QUITE A HANDFUL was urged to the lead along the inside, disputed the

pace for six furlongs and gave way on the far turn
