SHEDROW HERO secured a tracking position between foes in the second flight while under some reserve racing into the turn, shifted out to split foes four wide in upper stretch, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and went clear under brisk handling. APPLESOLUTELY WILD exchanged bumps with CAPTAIN JACK in the opening stages while moving to a position just off the second flight just off the inside, was steadied in close quarters near the three furlong marker, shifted out five wide entering upper stretch and continued well enough to narrowly prevail for the place. CAPTAIN JACK exchanged bumps with a rival in the opening stages while making his way to the inside, came through close quarters to save ground on the bend to upper stretch, then threaded his way through close quarters racing through the stretch to gain a share. PARK BOYS angled inwards while under pressure to gain terms with the a rival on the lead, prompted the pace outside that foe into upper stretch but couldn't sustain his momentum. GRAZIE, shuffled back out of tight quarters early, made some effort to regain contention while shifting out five wide entering upper stretch but had no final response while appearing to hop some tracks in the final furlong. SORREL OF THE SEA tracked just off the leaders three deep racing to the bend, made a brief bid in that path nearing upper stretch but came up empty in the drive. HART OF A COWBOY tracked just off the first flight near the inside racing to the bend, came through along the rail to challenge in upper stretch, was steadied sharply when shut off approaching the furlong marker, shifted out a bit while regaining his stride but couldn't menace further. CAP'N MEDS tracked the leaders six wide between foes racing to the bend and never gained contention. SILKEN PRINCE exchanged bumps after the start, was roused to contend along the inside, disputed the lead inside a rival to upper stretch, then drifted in nearing the furlong marker while giving way.

BABY CARLOS, off a step slowly, never gained contention while racing along the inside. BELELIU, caught seven wide between foes early, never menaced.
R RICH E. RICH, caught eight wide racing to the turn, soon dropped out.
