Footnotes

PADDY O'PRADO, held up just off the inside leading the second flight to the backstretch, shifted three wide nearing the quarter mile marker while under some pressure to advance, responded approaching the furlong marker to wrest command and edged clear in the final stages under firm left handed pressure. WIGMORE HALL (IRE), off a step slowly, was guided to the inside racing under some reserve off the second flight, continued between foes on the backstretch into the far turn racing just off the second flight, angled four wide momentarily shifting into the path of MISTER MARTI GRAS leaving the quarter mile marker and continued with interest to secure the place in late stages while never quite gaining terms with the winner. WORKIN FOR HOPS shifted inwards gaining a forward placing in the opening quarter, maintained terms with the pacesetter while in hand in the opening half, steadily moved on terms with the leader to press that foe nearing upper stretch, disputed the issue between foes to the furlong marker but weakened when failing to match the winner late. CHEROKEE LORD moved to the fore while angling to the inside in the opening stages, dictated the pace under rating to the second bend, briefly resisted his challengers racing through upper stretch but weakened in the last furlong. DEAN'S KITTEN was settled in hand just off the inside early, angled to the rail entering the backstretch, made brief progress to gain striking distance inside foes on the second bend but came up empty entering upper stretch. MISTER MARTI GRAS, reserved just off the eventual winner as part of the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued outside foes to the second bend, was forced five wide nearing upper stretch and quickly faded from contention.
