Footnotes

IMPERSONATOR stumbled at the start, was quickly righted to gain terms with a rival on the lead near the inside, stalked that foe along the rail to upper stretch, shifted outside that foe near midstretch and took over, drifting out late under pressure. PERJURY, bumped at the start by CALL TO GLORY, was righted to track just off the first flight along the inside racing into the turn, shifted out into the path of FAIRING entering upper stretch exchanging some contact with that rival but found his best stride late racing nearest the rail to secure second. WHEEMAWAY settled near the inside in the opening stages, saved ground gradually gaining contention, shifted off the inside in upper stretch and threaded his way through rivals to gain a share. CALL TO GLORY broke outwards bumping PERJURY, prompted the pace outside a rival from the break, edged forward to a clear advantage racing into the stretch but faltered late. MAVERICKING, held up between foes in the opening stages, shifted outside foes gathering some momentum leaving the turn, angled five wide racing through the stretch and made some mild progress. AFLEET PADDY, reserved well off the inside in the opening half, passed inside only tiring rivals in the drive. FAIRING tracked the leaders three between foes in second flight racing to the bend, was bumped in upper stretch and steadily faded from contention. INCLUDING WARDO tracked the leaders along the inside, then steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. TRUBS, caught four wide in the second flight racing to the bend, dropped out nearing upper stretch.
