COLOR ME BLUE hopped a bit at the start, was caught four wide racing to the first turn gaining a forward placing while in hand, tracked just off the leaders to the second bend, commenced a steady, three wide bid nearing upper stretch, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and drew clear under pressure. RULER OF THE COURT was urged to the lead along the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to midstretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner. CHARLIE BABY, a bit unruly before the start, settled along the inside in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch and improved position inside foes. TIMELESS FACTS angled to the inside tracking just off the leaders in the opening stages, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. PULLMANITE, forwardly placed between foes racing to the first turn, angled to the inside on the backstretch to stalk the first flight, shifted out three deep leaving the far turn to challenge but flattened out nearing midstretch. COUNTRY TOWN was settled off the inside racing to the backstretch and offered no rally. BUD SYMONDS, unhurried near the inside early, never mounted a serious challenge. DURAZNO attended the pace outside a rival racing to the far turn, gave way abruptly nearing upper stretch, then was taken in hand in the last furlong after his rider lost his whip.
