**Footnotes**

SCHOOL ON A HILL was rated off the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, steadily drew into striking distance inside foes on the far turn, switched out splitting foes racing into upper stretch and continued with a solid closing response to gain a clear advantage under pressure. MIGHTY BROWN broke slowly, was settled between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, made steady progress four wide on the far turn to challenge for command in that path nearing upper stretch but couldn't match the winner's final kick. SMARTY'S ECHO drifted wide racing into the first turn while dropping off the second flight racing to the backstretch, then continued with a steady four wide advance racing into the stretch to gain position to the end while earning a share. POKER PLAYER tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight under rating racing to the backstretch, then continued with an even effort to improve position between foes racing through the stretch. LINGUINI was urged to secure the lead while angling inside racing to the first turn, set the pace on a narrow margin into the far turn but gave way once headed by the winner in upper stretch. ARCHYBDANCING, caught wide racing into the first turn, never gained contention. HURRICANE PASS was held up tracking off the first flight between foes racing to the backstretch and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. STEEL VICE tracked the leaders inside rivals in the second flight early, shifted out nearing the far turn to lodge a brief bid between foes but emptied out racing into upper stretch. NORTHERN EMPIRE, reserved avoiding close quarters in the opening stages, never mounted a serious challenge. SPOT, caught outside foes prompting the pace racing to the backstretch, continued three deep into the second bend and steadily retreated racing into upper stretch.
