FOREST ATTACK broke sharply and opened up, drew clear in the stretch and was ridden out. DRINKS TO GO raced in the middle of the pack and made a rail rally to be second best. ONE LUCKY DEVIL was void of speed, split horses in the turn and made a late rally. DEFENDER'S WORD pressed the pace between horses and faded late in the stretch. FLIGHTWITHOUTWINGS stumbled badly after the start, showed no speed and passed tiring rivals. TRIBUTE TO BOB broke sharply and dropped back, was six wide on the turn a faded. MELLO BUT CRAFTY got off slowly and was far back and was no threat. SPIRITO raced in the second flight between horses and tired at the top of the stretch. DOC'S CHANCE raced in the middle of the pack, was asked but made no rally. THE RUNNING OF RACE SIX WAS DELAYED DUE TO SEVERE WEATHER.
