Footnotes

SACRISTY was settled between foes racing behind the second flight from just out of striking distance racing into the bend, shifted out five wide entering upper stretch while being roused to advance, drifted inwards under pressure while making steady progress, wrested command then pulled clear in time while being taken in hand nearing the wire. ST. LOUIS CITY broke readily to gain the advantage, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the inside racing into the bend, extended her advantage in upper stretch but proved only second best when confronted by the winner. RETAIL REGER, forwardly placed between foes in the opening stages, prompted the pacesetter racing into the turn, couldn't match that foe after a half but continued with interest to hold a rival for a share. OH CAROLE settled off the second flight while angling to the inside in the opening stages, shifted out to split foes three deep in upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to improve position. ROCKET TWENTYONE ducked in at the start, was quickly righted to track off the first flight along the inside racing into the turn but had no closing bid. DOLLY PEACH settled off the second flight outside foes in the opening quarter, was caught four wide racing through the turn while being prompted to advance and lacked the needed final bid. OUR DOMAIN settled in last near the inside early and never gained contention. KEL'S DREAMER was a brief factor three deep tracking just off the pacesetter racing into the bend but steadily retreated entering upper stretch.
