PARTY VISION was urged to gain the advantage shifting a bit off the rail in the opening stages, dictated the pace on her own courage maintaining a narrow margin inside foes racing into the bend, shook clear when given her cue entering upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm right handed prompting. CHILEAN DREAMS tracked just off the first flight outside a rival in the opening stages, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch while being urged to advance, continued in that path racing through the stretch and proved best of the others while failing to gain terms with the winner. AUTUMN SPLENDOR, within striking distance three deep in the opening stages, was urged to prompt the leader in that path racing into upper stretch, weakened in late stages but continued well enough to earn a share. MIRKA was urged to join the pace between foes, attended the leader's tempo racing into the bend but came up empty racing into upper stretch. MADAME MISTLETOE, a bit slow to gather stride, made her way to the rail racing through the backstretch, saved ground to upper stretch and continued with an even effort to improve her position inside foes in late stages. G G GAL tracked just off the first flight while angling inside early, continued in that path racing into the bend, but steadily faded racing into upper stretch while switching off the inside. COURTESY CALL settled into stride a bit off the inside while racing in last through the backstretch, was fanned five wide racing into the stretch but made no impression. LITTLE WHITE STAR settled outside a rival in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge.
