**Footnotes**

DON'TWAIT TOOLONG broke slowly, swung out wide for the drive, brushed STORMING MARINE and dueled late in the lane. STORMING MARINE was void of early speed, made a sweeping move in the turn, dueled and was brushed in the lane and just missed. RED CHILL was bumped at the start, found his best stride too late and was gaining six wide. COMMAND SGT. MAJOR saved ground, altered course in the stretch and had a late gain. HIGH APPROVAL (IRE) raced evenly, was boxed inside in the stretch then rallied when clear. KAPAK (GB) had no speed, lacked room inside in the stretch then angled out too late. SWEETSOUTHERNSTYLE raced mid pack, bumped in the stretch and had no late kick. CUBAN MISSILE set the pace, opened up the lead early and gave way. STORM BOOT LARRY pressed the pace and raced widest in the stretch and stopped. FOREST WILDFIRE placed forwardly, was shut off and bumped in the stretch and stopped. RACE RUN IN LANE 5.
