MILLENNIUM STAR, guided to the inside early while being rated just off the first flight, continued in that fashion to the second bend, shifted out three deep to split foes entering upper stretch while being roused to challenge, gained a narrow advantage leaving midstretch and just maintained that margin to the end under firm handling. MARGO'S DELIGHT, reserved in last along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted outside foes racing through the far turn, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch but made solid progress to the end to close the gap while edging several foes for place honors. LAWFUL LADY took up a tracking position behind the second flight saving ground under reserve in the opening half, came through between foes just off the inside to challenge inside the leaders in upper stretch and continued willingly to the end while just outkicked by the top pair. GHOST ON THE RUN was urged to secure terms with a rival on the pace racing into the first turn, attended that foe's tempo for a half, pressed the issue between foes on the far turn to midstretch while gaining the advantage but yielded to the top trio in the final sixteenth. PURE VALUE, reserved out of close quarters in the opening stages, switched out three deep while rated off the second flight racing to the backstretch, dropped into last awaiting an opening on the far turn, swung seven wide racing into the stretch and made some mild progress late. SILVER CRUSH, reserved off the second flight outside a rival in the opening stages, was urged to advance on the far turn while caught four wide between foes and lacked the needed final kick. BACARELLA shifted out early to track off the first flight between foes racing to the far turn and steadily faded nearing midstretch. ONEDAYATATYME, pulling a bit early while tracking off the first flight, steadily advanced on the leaders three

deep to lodge a brief bid racing through the far turn but quickly flattened out in upper stretch. MS. CAUTION was urged to the lead while angling to the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the second bend but emptied out abruptly after six furlongs.
