Footnotes

MONGOL MAX, prominent between foes from the outset, was eased off the leaders while shifting to the inside entering the bend, came through inside foes to regain command in upper stretch and steadily widened his advantage under firm encouragement. TIZ SENSATIONAL, steadied a bit avoiding tight quarters after being bumped at the start, was reserved in hand along the rail while steadily gathering momentum racing into the bend, shifted out to split foes near the inside in upper stretch and was roused to edge a rival for place honors in the closing stages. DOUBLE CROSSING (IRE) broke inwards making some contact with TIZ SENSATIONAL at the start, was held up outside that foe in the last flight early, made steady progress to regain contention while shifting out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to the end while being just outfinished for second. TWO LIONS, within striking distance early while being guided to the inside to track just off the first flight, continued evenly into the stretch while being outfinished for a share. CLYDE BANK, pulling a bit outside foes in the opening stages, moved to force the issue three deep racing into the turn, continued in that path to upper stretch and weakened in late stages. ON YOUR SIDE, reserved between foes while shifting nearer to the inside tracking off the second flight, was held up avoiding tight quarters racing into upper stretch, shifted out six wide racing through the stretch but made no real impression while gaining some position. RUNNINGOUT OF CASH, urged to dispute the pace along the inside from the break, shifted off the rail leaving the midway point of the turn dueling for command and gave way leaving midstretch when failing to match the winner. LONG DRAW tracked the leaders four wide early racing as part of the second flight, continued between foes into the turn and steadily retreated racing into upper stretch.
