ARTFUL BEE was urged to dispute the pace while shifting off the rail crossing into the paths of several foes racing into the first turn, dictated terms on a

narrow margin to the second bend, was roused clear in upper stretch, then shifted out in late stages while being urged to repel a bid from CHARLIES SWELL bumping that foe but holding that challenger safe to the end under brisk handling. The latter, held up avoiding close quarters racing into the first turn, shifted to the inside to track behind the second flight in the opening half, shifted out on the far turn splitting foes while steadily moving to striking position, shifted out four wide in upper stretch while being roused to gain terms with the leader but failed to edge that foe after being bumped nearing the wire. AZTEC RUN, firmly rated avoiding some traffic racing just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, continued to stalk the leader along the inside to the second bend and continued evenly between foes near the inside in late stages. AFLEET PADDY settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, made some progress to split foes four wide in upper stretch, then angled inwards in late stages while making an effort to improve his placing. DYNAMIC ROYAL, reserved along the rail in the last flight in the opening stages, shifted outside foes on the far turn while being urged to advance, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch but continued willingly in that path to late stages. HE'S GOT TO RUN was settled between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out nearing the far turn while being prompted to advance, was fanned seven wide racing into the stretch but continued with a mild bid. PLAYON PLAYER came through close quarters in the opening stages to prompt the pacesetter, was eased off that foe after a half to track off the first flight, shifted out three deep on the second bend while being urged to make a second challenge but quickly flattened out. SIDESPLITTING reserved off the second flight racing four wide to the backstretch, continued with a steady effort while caught four wide between foes nearing upper stretch and failed to sustain that effort through the final quarter. GRAND SILVER settled into stride off the second flight saving ground in the opening stages and never gained contention. BLUE LASER tracked the pace outside foes behind the second flight in the opening stages and retreated from contention early. J STORM caught four, then five racing wide into the first turn, dropped out of contention early. NICKELACROSS joined the pace three deep while floated a bit wide racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue racing into the far turn and gave way abruptly after six furlongs.
