Footnotes

RED ALL OVER moved to secure terms with several rivals on the pace while under some reserve between foes in the opening stages, steadily asserted himself racing into upper stretch to gain a narrow advantage and edged forward in the last furlong under steady handling and some left handed encouragement. AMALFI RUNNER was urged to dispute the pace along the rail from the break, continued to resist the winner's challenge racing into upper stretch and was narrowly outfinished in late stages. BROWNEYED BACHELOR, unhurried between foes early, angled to the inside entering the turn taking up a position just off the first flight, shifted out three deep nearing midstretch and continued with a mild bid to close the gap and earn a share. VIVA MONGOLIA tracked off the first flight three deep between foes racing to the bend, angled five wide entering upper stretch and made some late progress to improve position. DEVIL KISSES tracked the leaders along the rail racing into the bend but offered no closing response. CHOCTAW DRIVE, in close attendance to the pace three wide early, couldn't match terms with the top pair despite pressure after a half and steadily faded from contention nearing midstretch. MISFIRED tracked the first flight from within striking distance while caught four wide racing to the bend but steadily retreated after a half.
