GRETA'S RAP sped away to a clear advantage along the inside soon after the break, dictated the pace on her own courage through the turn, then extended her advantage through the stretch under firm left handed encouragement. LONGER VERSION, reserved from striking distance along the inside in the opening stages, shifted off the inside racing through the bend while continuing under some reserve, split foes three deep entering upper stretch and made steady late progress to prevail for place honors. SANCERRE, a step slow into stride, shifted out in the opening quarter gaining a position just off the second flight, made some progress to challenge three deep entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. STATIC KILL, held up three deep off the second flight in the opening stages, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and continued evenly to late stages. POLAR EXPEDITION was guided to the inside tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance racing into the turn but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. FULLCOURTPRESSURE angled inwards gaining a position just off the pacesetter racing into the turn, came through inside a rival to challenge nearing upper stretch but quickly came up empty leaving the furlong marker. FOXY ON SUNDAY broke slowly, settled into stride, continued under some reserve to the lane but never gained contention. COME ON MAN, prominent three deep in the opening stages, came under pressure to lodge a brief bid nearing upper stretch but quickly emptied out.
