Footnotes

LEMON CUSTARD, reserved from out of striking distance along the inside in the opening half, commenced a steady advance to contention inside foes on the far turn, shifted off the inside nearing midstretch and continued with a steady response to just gain even terms with PEDROLINO on the wire under firm right handed encouragement. The latter responded to some prompting to secure the lead along the inside soon after the start, moved away to a clear advantage racing to the backstretch while being firmly rated, maintained a sizeable advantage to upper stretch, responded when called upon to resist his rival's challenge to the end and just maintained his advantage to the wire under brisk left handed prompting. TUCKY settled into stride along the inside in the opening half, gradually drew into contention shifting out three deep racing into the far turn, continued in that path to close the gap on the pacesetter racing through the stretch but was just outkicked by the top pair. ALARMING AFLEET tracked the leader outside a rival as part of the second flight from just out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, made some brief progress to gain second racing into the far turn but lacked the needed closing bid. GOLD FORMER tracked off the second flight outside a rival racing to the far turn but offered no rally. CAST A COLD EYE, urged to secure a forward placing tracking the pacesetter from just out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, was spent after a half.
