SAAR was guided to the inside early gaining a position just off the pacesetter in second flight, continued in that fashion into the second bend, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch while continuing in hand, then came through inside foes in the closing stages to wrest a narrow advantage in time under firm handling. TSUNAMI KING settled into stride along the inside tracking the leaders from out of striking distance, steadily gained position inside foes on the far turn, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch and made solid progress to the end while just outkicked by the winner. TIZ A SCHOLAR tracked the pace between foes off the second flight early, made steady progress to challenge the leaders three deep nearing upper stretch, continued between foes in that path to late stages and was just outfinished. RULEROUS, urged to secure the lead while shifting to the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin for a half, dueled for command just off the rail racing into upper stretch and yielded to the leaders in late stages. JOHNNY CADILLAC settled out of striking distance near the inside in the opening stages and made some mild progress inside foes to improve position late. SON OF TIGER tracked the pacesetter three deep in second flight racing to the backstretch, was urged to prompt the leader racing into the far turn but weakened between foes in upper stretch. CONDITION RED, caught four wide racing to the backstretch, never gained striking distance. WATCH CUPID tracked off the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the far turn and came up empty nearing upper stretch. REPENT N RECEIVE shifted the off inside early while gaining a position just off the pacesetter, tracked the between foes in second flight but was through after a half.
