IDEAL ALLUVIAL broke readily, attended the pace four deep under light rating racing to the bend, moved to challenge for command in that path entering upper stretch, shifted in under pressure while being roused to turn back a challenge from OH MY TODD and edged that foe late under pressure. The latter tracked off the second flight near the inside early, shifted out splitting foes on the turn advancing to contention, shifted out five wide in upper stretch, drew on terms with the winner but was outkicked in the closing stages. ON THE RUN, reserved near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out on the turn to split foes three deep racing into upper stretch and made a steady effort to improve his position. GO POSSE GO, outpaced in the opening stages, swung seven wide racing into the stretch and offered a belated response. A NICE SLEWISH BOY tracked off the second flight outside foes, shifted out racing into upper stretch but continued with an effort to improve position. GIMME A DOUBLE tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight racing to the turn, was fanned six wide while making a brief bid nearing upper stretch and lacked the needed final response. SWAP UP angled to the inside tracking the pace in second flight, shifted out to split foes racing through the stretch but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. PEACE NOW pressed the pace along the rail racing through the backstretch, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. BANJAMMER joined the pace three deep between foes in the opening stages, dueled in that path racing into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch. OLD KIT BAG was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the outset and gave way after a half.
