Footnotes

DISTANT BUGLE was urged to force the pace outside a rival from the outset racing into the bend, edged forward to a clear advantage in upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. MILITARY LEGEND settled into stride in last along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch and found his best stride nearing the furlong marker to gain position inside foes while securing the place honors. ROYALLY OUTFOXED tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight racing into the bend and continued evenly into the stretch while prevailing for a share. MR. FLEXIBLE was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival while shifting to the rail early, dueled for command racing through the bend and gave way entering upper stretch. SLICK MICK settled off the second flight outside a rival in the opening stages, was fanned five wide racing into the stretch while being prompted to gain some position but made no real impression on the leaders. COCKY BULL angled inwards to track between foes in the second flight racing into the bend but steadily faded after a half. SCOTCHIRISH was rated off the second flight in the opening stages, made brief progress while shifting out three deep racing through the turn but quickly emptied out entering upper stretch.
