Footnotes

NEVER LOVLIER was urged between foes to gain a forward placing tracking just off the dueling leaders racing into the backstretch, steadily moved to wrest command three deep while on her own courage racing through the far turn, drifted wide while maintaining a clear advantage in upper stretch and continued willingly to hold MUNHALL MISS to the end under pressure. The latter worked her way to the inside early while dropping well off the second flight, commenced a steady advance along the rail nearing upper stretch to gain striking distance inside the winner late but proved only second best. CHICA SILVER tracked off the second flight while angling to the inside racing into the backstretch, shifted off the inside on the far turn while awaiting an opening nearing upper stretch, then angled four wide racing through the lane while continuing willingly to prevail for a share. C'MON FEET shifted in early while tracking off the second flight under light reserve in the opening half, was urged to advance three wide between foes racing through the far turn to upper stretch, then finished evenly between foes in late stages. DANCING FLASHY tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight, was steadied off tiring foes racing into the far turn, shifted out in traffic nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. ABBY'S SLEW stumbled at the start, settled into stride to the far turn and passed some tiring rivals late. SCORPIOBDANCING, shuffled back at the start, never gained contention. ANNIE'S SHOWTIME was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing into the backstretch, couldn't match the winner's pace after six furlongs and gave way racing into the stretch. SEE NO STARS, caught four wide racing to the backstretch while racing as part of the second flight, was through after a half. JUKEBOX GEM was urged to join the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch, was spent after five furlongs and drifted wide nearing the stretch while quickly giving way.
