### Footnotes

BAENA raced inside near the middle of the field, angled out for the drive and prevailed after coming out from a left handed whip in the stretch. VOODOO FEVER raced close up inside, rallied to the lead in the stretch and just failed to last. SHINGWEDZI raced off the rail near the middle of the field, steadied in the stretch and gained belatedly. STORMCLOUDRISING set the pace from the inside on a clear lead and weakened. QUEEN COLLEEN lacked speed inside and was never a factor. IS THIS GOOD raced off the rail and was always outrun. MT. KATMAI stalked the pace from off the rail and tired. (Race run in lane 1, rail in 10 feet.).
