Footnotes

TWENTYONEANDTWO broke sharply, moved to the rail while opening a clear margin on her rivals, dictated the pace under light rating racing into the bend, shook clear when challenged in upper stretch and held sway to the end under pressure. I'M NOT AFRAID angled inwards soon after the break, tracked off the second flight near the inside to upper stretch, shifted out to split foes three wide leaving the furlong marker and was getting to the winner late. LADY JADANA, held up out of tight quarters at the start, continued along the inside racing into the turn racing behind the second flight, shifted out four wide leaving the furlong marker while finding her best stride and was making solid progress late. LIZ HUNTER worked her way to the inside tracking just off the pacesetter, angled out a bit entering upper stretch making momentary contact with BOUCHON while under pressure to challenge the leader but was outkicked. BOUCHON shifted outside the pacesetter while leading the second flight under some reserve racing into the turn, moved to briefly challenge nearing upper stretch, exchanged some contact with a rival and faded in the drive. LOVE IN BLOOM tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight, continued three deep into upper stretch and retreated in the drive. LADYFLICKERFLACKER bobbled at the start, recovered to track the leaders off the second flight between foes racing to the turn but was spent early. LAVA LADY, a bit slow into stride, tracked the pace in the last flight racing three deep to the bend and dropped out early.
