LIL BIT O'FUN, held up out of close quarters at the break while exchanging some light contact with CANDY TRAIN, was guided to the inside to track just off the leaders, awaited an opening near the quarter mile marker, shifted outside a tiring foe, then angled to the inside in upper stretch, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and went clear under firm handling. ULTIMATE DECISION stalked just off the first under some reserve in the opening stages, advanced to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch, secured the place in the drive but proved no match for the winner. DONT TOUCH MY GOLD disputed the pace outside a rival from the break, dueled with that foe into the bend, continued to force the issue between the top pair to midstretch but gave way late. JUST FOR FRANK broke inwards brushing CANDY TRAIN, was righted to track just off the leaders racing four wide to the bend, made a brief bid in that path on the turn but flattened out in upper stretch. CANDY TRAIN, squeezed a bit between foes at the start, tracked the leaders off the inside racing to the turn, angled to the rail avoiding a drifting foe entering upper stretch, continued with interest but made no impression. CHUNKY, off a step slowly, tracked the leaders along the inside, shifted out near the quarter mile marker to challenge but quickly dropped out. BLACKHAWK RED briefly disputed the pace along the rail, gave way entering upper stretch, then was steadied a bit in traffic nearing the furlong marker.
