Footnotes

MISS INCLINED, forwardly placed along the inside racing into the first turn, tracked the pacesetter under some reserve from just out of striking distance to upper stretch, shifted off the inside and responded well to wrest command and draw clear under steady prompting. INSIDE DEAL, on terms with several foes in the first flight racing into the first turn, inherited the lead midway through that bend, went clear on the backstretch, held sway under rating to upper stretch but couldn't fend off the winner in the last furlong. COUNTESS VINDI worked her way to the inside in early stages tracking off the second flight, shifted out a bit to split foes in upper stretch, drifted out under pressure while making some progress and continued well enough to earn a share. EDIE, caught three or four deep in second flight, drifted out on the first turn bumping COURTESY CALL, continued to make steady progress on the second bend while shifting out five wide and made mild progress to the end. COURTESY CALL, bumped and caught five wide racing through the first turn, continued outside foes to upper stretch in an even effort. MS. TIPTAPTOE reserved saving ground tracking in second flight, came up empty entering upper stretch. HOLY HEAVENS tracked the pace between foes in the second flight, made a brief bid racing through the far turn but flattened out. LADY JORDAN, reserved between foes in the opening half, offered no rally. MILK DUDETTE, on terms with the first flight from the outset, bore out racing through the turn, righted her course to track just off and outside the leaders to the second bend but faded from contention early. TAKE NOTE OF ME saved ground to the backstretch and soon trailed.
