SPECTACULAR KID, in touch with the leaders in the opening stages, was held up just off those foes while angling to the inside after the opening furlong, continued under some reserve into the bend, shifted out entering upper stretch while commencing a steady advance, then just edged SAINT LEON in the final strides under firm right handed encouragement. The latter, urged to the fore along the inside from the outset, dueled for command along the rail through the turn, shook clear in upper stretch and just failed to contain the winner. FORESTRY TYPE was prompted to join the pace outside foes soon after the break, pressed the issue outside a rival to upper stretch but weakened nearing the furlong marker. KARAMA tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail from just out of striking distance racing to the turn, shifted off the inside in upper stretch and made some mild progress in late stages to just miss for a share. A DIEHL bobbled at the start, was settled outside a rival racing to the turn and never mounted a serious challenge.
