THIRD CHANCE took up a position racing just off the first flight while under light rating in the opening stages, steadily moved to striking distance while shifting out three deep nearing upper stretch, came around a drifting rival to engage the pacesetter midstretch and put that foe away in late stages under firm handling. KIP BERRIES was urged to dispute the pace from the outset while shifting to the rail, edged forward to a clear advantage entering upper stretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner. LADY CHESTERFIELD tracked off the second flight a bit off the inside while unhurried in the opening stages, shifted out five deep in upper stretch and made some progress to improve her position while prevailing for a share. PALAZZO BABE tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance outside a rival racing into the bend, shifted out to race four deep between foes through the stretch and continued evenly to late stages. PAGE SPRINGS angled inwards to force the pace outside a rival racing into the bend, drifted out nearing upper stretch and gave way. MUSICAL PRODIGY bobbled at the start, was collected to track the leaders along the rail, saved ground to upper stretch gaining some position but had no closing bid.
