FLY BOY ROY ducked inwards at the start, came under pressure early chasing the pacesetter inside a rival racing into the turn, shifted outside the leader while moving to terms with that foe nearing upper stretch, continued under strong handling in a prolonged drive but edged forward in late stages to prove best. BAHAMIAN RUM was hustled clear along the inside racing into the bend, dueled for command into upper stretch but proved no match for the winner late. MIDNIGHT CALL, bumped just after the start, was righted to track the leaders along the rail, saved ground to upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. J EVANS tracked off the second flight in the opening stages, shifted out four wide in upper stretch but had no closing bid. CALL M'EV E MAYBE, forced inwards by the eventual winner into the path of MIDNIGHT CALL just after the start, was righted to chase the leaders along the inside racing into the bend, continued between foes into upper stretch and faded in late stages. FROSTYS WHIRL, urged to gain a position outside a rival in the second flight, steadily faded racing into upper stretch. A J MOON broke slowly and never gained contention.
