Footnotes

WILD L, bumped by BIG LOOIE at the start and forced into the path of ALL TANKED UP, angled to the inside tracking the pace unhurried, steadily gathered momentum entering the bend, shifted off the inside with a quarter mile to go, angled three deep in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to edge BULLET FROM ABROAD in the final strides under pressure. The latter broke sharply, disputed the pace inside a rival racing into the turn, edged clear midway through the bend, held sway to late stages but couldn't fend off the winner late. YANKEE INJUNUITY tracked the leaders in second flight along the inside, advanced on those foes along the rail into upper stretch, raced in close quarters past the furlong marker, then shifted out in late stages exchanging some contact with MAM BIRD while continuing with some interest to earn a share. MAM BIRD prompted the pace outside a rival racing into the turn, weakened racing though the lane when failing to match that foe, then lost his momentum when bumped nearing the wire. BIG LOOIE broke outwards bumping WILD L, bumped, tracked the pace outside foes into the bend but offered no rally. ALL TANKED UP, bumped at the start, recovered to track just off the leaders three wide into the bend, then steadily retreated in the drive. RIVER BEAR tracked the pace between foes in second flight, then steadily faded nearing upper stretch.
