SATELLITE TRICK, on terms with the pacesetter from the break, stalked just outside that foe into the bend, couldn't match terms with the leader nearing upper stretch, but produced a solid response in the final sixteenth to wrest command from that foe and just hold GOLDPOINT under firm encouragement. The latter, reserved between foes, angled to the inside after the opening quarter, steadied momentarily nearing the bend, continued inside foes nearest the rail to upper stretch, found his best stride late to challenge inside the winner and just missed. OUTLAW ZEN, unhurried between foes in the opening stages, angled five wide nearing upper stretch while gathering momentum and was going well late. OUTLAW BOUNTY angled to the inside dictating the pace on a narrow margin, edged away to a clear advantage racing into upper stretch but faltered late. GAGE PARK, caught in tight quarters at the start, was settled off the inside, shifted out entering upper stretch and improved his position. BOB'S MOUNTAIN, forwardly placed from the break, pressed the pace racing three wide on the turn and gave way. DONTA tracked just off the first flight along the inside, steadied off foes nearing the turn, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch and steadily faded. LUCKY PINS tracked the pace off the inside and offered no rally. CANNON'S CALL was never a factor. IN THE DETAILS, caught in tight quarters at the start, dropped out early.
