Footnotes

MILES AND MILES, unhurried between foes in the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out to advance four wide leaving the midway point of the second bend, continued willingly between foes into upper stretch and narrowly prevailed under firm handling. BROKERAGE HOUSE, held up out of tight quarters just after the start, saved ground to the far turn while steadily regaining contention, shifted out five wide leaving the far turn to challenge, drew on terms with the leader in upper stretch but was outfinished. COOL CLUE dictated the pace from the break along the inside, edged clear to a narrow advantage on the far turn, set the pace into upper stretch but couldn't sustain his momentum. FRANK'S TIME angled inwards to track just off the leaders racing to the far turn, bid between foes into the lane but had no final response. MOLANDER, caught four wide racing to the backstretch tracking just off the leaders, made a brief bid outside foes on the far turn but flattened out nearing upper stretch. RIVERSIDE RASCAL prompted the pace outside a rival into the far turn, then gave way nearing upper stretch.
