Footnotes

SARATHTHETIGER was settled off the inside in the opening half, circled foes four wide on the second bend to wrest command in the final sixteenth and drew clear under pressure. HOLLY AT LAW, bumped at the start, recovered to track the pace between foes in second flight to upper stretch and prevailed for the place. LOVES TO FLY angled to the inside while being urged to the lead racing to the first turn, went well clear on the backstretch, held sway past the furlong marker but faltered in late stages. CAT BELLS tracked off the second flight outside a rival, advanced three wide racing on the far turn to striking distance but had no final kick. HELLO JAKE, steadied out of close quarters just off the second flight early, tracked the leaders along the inside to upper stretch, then was taken in hand when racing in traffic in late stages. VAULTS LAST SISTER, caught four wide racing into the first turn, never gained striking distance. BANDI KAY was settled along the inside but never gained contention. TATIBITATI broke out, bumped HOLLY AT LAW, recovered to lead the

second flight to the far turn and gave way. SHESA TOUGH KITTY was a brief factor outside foes in the second flight but gave way on the far turn. LIPSTICK LADY, caught four wide racing into the first turn, never gained contention. POBRECITA bobbed at the start, was settled along the inside, then was pulled up and walked off the course as a result of slipped saddle.
