Footnotes

SCORE BABY SCORE, reserved along the inside to the backstretch, steadily gathered momentum inside foes approaching the second bend, swung out five wide while quickly moving to command racing through the far turn, drew well clear in upper stretch and was kept to the task while widening his advantage. POPLAR HOUSE angled to the rail to gain a position in the second flight racing to the backstretch, made some progress to gain striking distance inside foes entering the far turn, altered course avoiding tight quarters midway through the second bend, shifted out to split foes three wide racing into upper stretch and proved best of the others. BLUE DAY IN MAY broke outwards bumping ENEMY FIRE, was settled into stride near the inside to the backstretch, saved ground on the second bend, shifted out in upper stretch and made an effort to improve his position three deep between foes. ESPRESSO was settled outside foes racing to the backstretch, angled five wide nearing upper stretch and made an effort to improve his placing. GIVING POINTS led the second flight in hand from just out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, made a brief bid four wide between foes racing through the far turn but came up empty after six furlongs. ENEMY FIRE, bumped at the start, was urged to dispute the pace along the rail racing into the backstretch, pressed the issue into the second bend and gave way nearing upper stretch. TAXCO was hustled to dispute the lead outside a rival racing to the backstretch and into the far turn, then emptied out nearing upper stretch. HOWARD WHO tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight in the opening half but steadily retreated entering the far turn.
