BUBBLE N SQUEAK set the pace from the inside while pressed and held sway to the wire. SWEET TALKER pressed the pace from just outside but could not get past the winner. ISABELL'S SHOES raced near the middle of the field, rallied in the stretch then lacked a winning bid. FIVE BELLS raced four wide near the middle of the field and made a bid on the turn but flattened out. ASK MOLLY raced five wide and was not a factor. HOPE OF NATIONS lacked speed and improved her position. KIDISA'S HONOR raced close up early but tired. GOLDRUSH LADY made an inside bid on the turn but faltered. PAINTED SMILE was through early. SAGE PRINCESS was always outrun. LIL JOSEY raced close up but gave way.
