WEGGIE saved ground, was taken up when lacked room in the stretch, split horses when clear and took the lead in the last strides. CANNON'S CALL had no speed, edged to the leaders in the stretch and got up for the place. HEZA HARLEY MAN stalked pace off the rail, led in the stretch but was caught late. TRIPLE CHECK was shuffled back at the start, made a bid in the stretch but was not good enough. PEARL EXPRESS was unruly in the gate, set a pressured pace then gave way late. KOKOMO GYPSY was void of early speed and failed to menace. I'VE GOT A SECRET broke inward, raced mid pack then dropped back.
