**Footnotes**

FIRST GUESS was allowed to settle early then angled five wide and made a steady advance to get up in time. BUTLER CABIN set the pace and battled inside, was headed in the stretch but came back before being caught late. WEBSTER pressed the pace and challenged the leader in the stretch, grabbed a brief lead before being outfinished. BUBBLING SPRINGS was well positioned early, made a bid into the stretch and race evenly. BEARS EARS raced under a tight hold and steadied early, rated in the second flight along the inside then ran on late. HIPPOCRATES JONES rated in the middle of the pack and saved ground, lacked room in the stretch but was never clear. CALDO CAT showed no speed, was asked while four wide and showed some late kick. ROULETTE WINNER got off slowly and dropped back, angled out into the stretch but made no rally. RELVADO rated in the middle of pack, made a bid between on the turn but made no rally. EL TIPO reared and hesitated at the start then dropped back and was no factor.
