PHOTO IMAGE raced in the middle of the pack, split horses in the turn then angled out in the stretch and rallied late to get up in time. GOLD SPIKE settled inside, split horses and made a steady late advance, led but was caught. GOLDINTHEPOCKET was rushed up to contend, was getting out into the turn, battled then was tiring but still held show. LEAWOOD settled off the pace, made a middle move but was outfinished. MISS ANN H dropped back, moved while four wide on the turn and made a mild rally. BROKEN SMILE got off slowly, showed no speed and made no rally. PAUL'S DREAM was void of speed, was asked in the stretch but didn't respond well to the whip. MARY SWAN set a pressured pace, steadied on the inside in the stretch and stopped. (RACE RUN ON TURF, 6 FEET OUTSIDE OF LANE 2)
