GLEAM OF HOPE broke readily to secure a forward placing stalking the pacesetter under light reserve in the opening half, moved to wrest command from that foe midway through the far turn, shook clear racing into upper stretch and withstood the challenge of COLOR ME BLUE to the end while shifting out in late stages despite firm right handed pressure. The latter broke outwards making light contact with WHERE'S THE BABY at the start, was righted to track the leaders inside that foe as part of the second flight under rating in the opening half, continued under patient handling while shifting out four wide nearing upper stretch, then made steady progress to the end when given his cue to draw on terms with the winner late while proving only second best. WHERE'S THE BABY, brushed at the start while shifting into the path of KEEP UP, was quickly righted to track the leaders outside a rival racing to the backstretch, shifted out three deep on the far turn while being prompted to challenge the eventual winner but couldn't match strides with top pair racing through the stretch. KEEP UP, squeezed a bit at the start, recovered to track off the second flight under light rating in the opening stages, saved ground into upper stretch and continued evenly to late stages. HELICOPTER, outpaced for six furlongs, never gained contention while making some effort to close the gap. ROCKIN AFLEET broke inwards crossing the path of KEEP UP while moving quickly to secure the lead along the inside, dictated the pace racing into the far turn and emptied out abruptly once headed by the winner.
