Footnotes

SHELLYS WILD secured a forward placing attending a rival's pace, pressed the issue racing into upper stretch and edged forward in late stages to prevail under steady handling. LAKOTA WOLF tracked the pace between foes in second flight, shifted out in upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to close the gap while proving only second best. DIVER urged to secure the lead while shifting to the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into upper stretch but weakened in late stages. SACRED RANGE reserved off the second flight along the rail racing into the turn, shifted out to split foes four wide in upper stretch and continued willingly to improve his position. RYAN'S REX tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight racing into the turn but lacked the needed late response. NO APOLOGIZES settled between foes in the last flight racing to the turn, then split foes three wide nearing upper stretch while continuing in an even effort. PLUNDER, came through close quarters in the opening stages to make some brief progress racing four wide into the turn but flattened out nearing upper stretch. EL JAKE, bumped at the start, was quickly righted to gain a position between foes in the second flight racing into the turn but faded from contention early. C. C. BANJO broke a bit slowly, was settled between foes, shifted out six wide racing through the turn and offered no rally. KISSAGREY broke inwards bumping EL JAKE, was collected off that foe to race in the last flight outside foes, was caught five wide between foes racing into the turn and never seriously menaced. SILVER ADDED, urged along three deep in the second flight racing into the turn dropped out of contention early.
