Footnotes

I GOT RHYTHM, in touch with the pacesetter from the outset, continued with a steady advance between foes on the turn to gain even terms with that rival in upper stretch, then edged forward in late stages under firm right handed encouragement. PRAIRIE PRIZE was urged to the fore along the inside from the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn, shifted out under left handed pressure nearing the furlong marker when resisting the winner's challenge but came up second best. I SEE MAMBO tracked just off the second flight while angling to the rail in the opening stages, saved ground throughout and made an effort to gain some position in the closing stages while prevailing for a share. I TURNED OUTLAW tracked just off and outside the first flight in the opening stages, made a steady advance to striking position three deep racing through the turn but lacked the needed final kick. NAUGHTY AND NICE settled in last near the inside from out of striking distance early, shifted out racing into upper stretch but made no impression. SECRET GLITTER tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the turn but steadily faded after a half.
