Footnotes

PIRATES VOW sprinted to the lead while angling inwards a bit, turned back a challenger to maintain a clear margin into upper stretch and held sway to the end under steady pressure. YANKEE INJUNUITY tracked off the second flight while angling inside early, saved ground to upper stretch and continued with interest to prevail for place honors late. UPSELL shifted outside rivals early tracking just off the leaders, loomed three deep on the turn to briefly challenge the eventual winner racing into upper stretch but flattened out late. PETERS ROCK angled inwards early while being urged to prompt the pacesetter racing into the turn but gave way racing into upper stretch. WEKIVA WACHEE tracked off the second flight while shifting outside foes racing to the turn, angled four wide entering upper stretch but failed to make a serious impression.
