STAND UP RITA was settled in hand dropping off the second flight early, saved ground on the bend gradually gathering momentum, came through close quarters just off the inside to split rivals nearing midstretch, then wrested command and surged clear late under steady handling. GULF BLVD tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight, made steady progress racing into the bend to challenge three deep between foes racing into upper stretch, gained the advantage between calls late but couldn't match terms with the winner. AMBITIOUS DANCER was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival from the outset, dueled for command into upper stretch and weakened leaving the furlong marker while continuing well enough to finish on even terms with a rival for a share. SHARP A was guided to the inside early to track the leaders from just out of striking distance, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch, then continued in traffic three deep between foes to late stages while continuing willingly to gain terms with a rival on the wire for a share. MONGOLIAN FRONT was urged to join the pace outside a rival from the outset, dueled for command into upper stretch while gaining a narrow advantage but gave out in late stages. MILLIES STAR, forwardly placed three deep tracking the first flight, was fanned four wide racing into upper stretch and steadily faded in late stages. ROMANCE THE DEVIL tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight, continued in that path while racing in traffic through the stretch and had no closing bid.
