LU KEEL lacked speed, angled out five wide for the drive and gained steadily to be along in the final strides. SHE'S A DRUMMER set the pace from the inside with a clear lead then could not last over the winner while shortening stride. CARINO DEULCE raced four wide near the middle of the field, rallied to loom a threat then flattened out in the late going. RURAL QUEEN rallied closer in the stretch but could not sustain her bid. LADY LOUWANE raced close up three wide and tired. MT. ST. MICHEL saved ground but tired. OUR SISTER TONETTE was always outrun. PROSTAR raced close up just outside and tired.
