

VICKI VALLENCOURT lacked speed inside, angled out for the drive and closed with determination to be along at the wire. DON'T RUFFLE ME raced close up four wide, rallied to a clear lead in the stretch and just failed to last over the winner. STRONG CREDENTIALS was void of early speed, angled wide for the drive and rallied for minor honors while no threat to the top two. EMERALDFORAJUDGE broke inward to bother DESERT SAGE, trailed to the stretch and improved her position in the drive. GLENBRIAR GIRL raced with the leaders three wide and tired. HONEST DECEIVER was close up between horses and tired. JUST SCARLET was always outrun. DESERT SAGE was bothered at the start, rushed up inside to set a pressured pace and tired in the drive.
