Footnotes

TODI BEE, reserved four deep off the second flight in the opening stages, made steady progress three wide entering the bend to draw on terms with the first flight nearing upper stretch, then wrested command in that path in the final sixteenth under firm handling. CHATFIELDS CHAP sped to the fore along the inside from the break, dueled for command along the rail into the turn, continued in an extended skirmish past midstretch, couldn't contain the winner but grudgingly held a rival for place honors. CUARTO CUATES, bumped at the start, quickly recovered to join the pace outside a rival after the opening furlong, pressed the issue outside that foe into upper stretch, struck the front nearing the furlong marker but couldn't match the winner and was outfinished for second. EXCLUSIVE KYLE tracked just off the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing into the turn, briefly awaited an opening entering upper stretch, then shifted out four wide in the final sixteenth while continuing with interest. R. CAMPFIRE hopped in the air at the start, was guided to the rail to track the leaders in the last flight racing into the bend, shifted off the rail entering upper stretch, then angled out five wide in late stages but continued with a mild bid. OLD LOW DOWN, held up between foes avoiding close quarters at the start, settled outside foes in the last flight racing into the turn, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch but proved no real threat. SMOKE N ASPHALT stumbled just after the start, was held up off the second flight in the opening stages, steadied in traffic nearing the turn and soon dropped out of contention. CHEROKEECHALLENGER broke outwards bumping CUARTO CUATES, was quickly righted to track between foes in the second flight in the opening stages but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch.
