Footnotes

COOL UNDER FIRE gained a contending position tracking the pacesetter outside a rival in second flight while maintaining striking distance racing to the turn, moved steadily to terms with the leader to force the issue nearing upper stretch, then edged forward racing through the lane while being kept to firm left handed encouragement. HOLDEN ON tracked the pace between foes in second flight under light rating racing into the turn, shifted out in close quarters to bid three deep between foes leaving midstretch and prevailed for place honors. VESPATO raced unhurried just off the second flight along the rail in the opening stages, was shuffled a bit in close quarters leaving the half mile marker, shifted out four wide on the bend, steadily drew into contention while being fanned six wide through the stretch but continued willingly to the end to close the gap while earning a share. LOOKING COOL, a bit slow into stride, saved ground on the turn gathering momentum, shifted out in upper stretch, then came through close quarters splitting foes five deep in late stages to gain some position. ENDURANCE broke slowly, was urged to gain a position three deep in the second flight, continued in that path to upper stretch but weakened in late stages while caught in some close quarters in the final sixteenth. COLLIN'S SMILE shifted to the inside to track just off the pacesetter racing into the turn, continued in that position to upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. ASK SIMON sped to the fore soon after the start while shifting to the rail, dictated the pace on a narrow margin under his own courage racing into the turn, briefly disputed the issue inside the winner racing into upper stretch but gave way leaving the furlong marker.
