Original nominees to pay \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed; after payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. WEIGHTS: Sunday, August 26, 2012. This event will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference will be Highweights (on the scale). *Total Earnings in 2012 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight (on the scale). Two (2) horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single ownership interest. Trophy to the owner of the winner. Footnotes

MIDDIE broke readily to gain a position just off the pacesetter racing a bit off the rail while under light rating in the opening half, shifted out while being urged to challenge entering the second bend, gained a commanding advantage racing into upper stretch and made the balance of the pace under some right handed pressure, then finished on his own courage once the issue was decided while setting a course record. MISTER MARTI GRAS shifted to the inside to track off the second flight in the opening stages while under some reserve, switched out on the far turn to split foes, then made steady progress three deep racing into the stretch to gain the place honors while never menacing the winner. POOL PLAY was settled in last while angling nearer to the inside in the opening stages, continued along the inside into the second bend, angled out nearing upper stretch to split foes three deep and made an effort to improve his position to the end. HATTAASH broke outwards bumping PRAYER FOR RELIEF, was held up avoiding some close quarters racing through the first turn to track off the second flight outside foes, continued outside foes to the second bend, was fanned five wide in upper stretch but made an effort to gain some position late. WORKIN FOR HOPS moved to the fore along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the second bend but had no response when challenged for command by the winner on the far turn and soon gave way. PRAYER FOR RELIEF, bumped at the start, was righted to track just off the leaders three deep racing to the backstretch, made a brief bid in that path approaching the far turn but quickly flattened out. BALLYJAMESDUFF, under pressure to contend in the opening stages, shifted off the rail to split foes on the first turn while moving to prompt the pacesetter, forced the issue for a half, quickly retreated entering the second bend, was outdistanced racing into the stretch, then walked off the course under his own power.
