Footnotes

COOL PREN raced just out of striking distance outside foes in the second flight in the opening half, steadily moved to challenge nearing upper stretch while shifting out four wide, continued in an extended skirmish for command and narrowly prevailed in the closing stages under firm handling. CLASSIC RECITAL moved to a forward placing three deep between foes racing through the first turn, continued with a steady bid to press the issue between foes in that path on the far turn to upper stretch, struck the front between calls late but just failed to contain the winner. BLAZING FINISH settled well off the second flight in the opening half, shifted outside foes racing through the far turn gathering momentum, swung six wide in upper stretch and found his best stride late to close the gap. MYLES, held up off the second flight in the opening half, continued three deep into the far turn, shifted to the inside in upper stretch while being roused to challenge between foes, exchanged some contact with OAK HARBOR in the closing stages but continued with a mild bid. SIR KIPLING settled outside foes racing off the second flight in the opening half, advanced to striking distance four deep on the far turn, continued five deep between foes into the stretch

but was outkicked in late stages. OAK HARBOR, pulling a bit between foes tracking the leaders in the second flight in the opening stages, shifted to the rail racing into upper stretch to challenge but lost his momentum after being bumped in late stages. DARK HUMORISTA pulled his way to terms with a rival on the pace while between foes racing to the backstretch, dictated the pace on a narrow margin between foes into the second bend, pressed the issue into upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. ITISTHESMARTMOVE settled into stride along the inside in the opening half and never mounted a serious challenge. BRIMMERTON, held up off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages, lost some position while racing in some traffic midway through the far turn and had no closing bid. BROKEN BOW, urged to secure a forward placing along the rail racing into the first turn, tracked just off the leaders along the inside to the second bend and gave way. STABLE CURRENCY drifted very wide on the first turn while under some prompting to gain a forward placing and dropped out of contention early.
